To evaluate whether live versus anatomic shape matching technique could yield different clinical outcomes for implant-supported restorations. MATERIALS AND METHODS: A total of 50 patients (25 males and 25 females, with an age range of 18 to 48 years) requiring single implant-supported prostheses were included in the present study. All patients were randomly assigned to the test or control group according to a simple random sampling method. The test group (n = 25) received implant prosthesis with the use of live shape matching technique, whereas the control group (n = 25) received implant prostheses with the use of conventional two-dimensional (2-D) planning and implant design. After 6 months of loading, all the restorations were assessed by a blinded examiner according to modified USPHS and LAD scores. The frequency of bone loss was also calculated. Results: The mean modified USPHS score for test and control groups was 5.60 and 5.40, respectively, while mean LAD score was 4.80 and 4.00, respectively, which was statistically not significant. The highest rate of bone loss was seen in the test group and the lowest rate was seen in the control group. A statistically significant difference in terms of bone loss was observed between the two groups (P
